APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- Motion to approve minutes from previous meeting made by Shannon Ritch, seconded by Dave Hankey; all in favor, none opposed.

REGISTRATION/BOOSTER HOURS

- Dave Hankey reported all but 10 families have completed their required 20 Booster Hours. Shannon has opportunity for those who are short to help at the Regionals hosted by Lakes this weekend.
- Dave states that in 2009-2010 there were 238 registered athletes. We have 189 currently registered athletes for the 2010/2011 season. There are 63 athletes which were registered last season but have not yet registered. With those added athletes, we will have approximately 250 athletes which will be a gain over last year. Further, there are currently 125 families registered. With the added families of those athletes who have yet to register we will have a total of 178 families for the 2010/2011 season.
- Dave requested and received volunteers to contact students in each grade that have not yet signed up.
- Janet Gerula says many families are unaware of registration, possibly because they do not use the internet. She believes we still need a registration day. Also, it would be a good idea if Lori Sullivan, could insure that the registration process and deadlines are outlined in the elementary, middle and high school newsletters, as well as on page one of the OLL School Home page, and under the Booster tab.
- Dave also provided a list to the gate, concession and apparel directors of parents who are interested in helping out to work off their registration fee.
- Dave is working on a sign-up form for next year which he will provide to the gate, concession and apparel directors so parents are awarded the hours they worked.
- Dave further requested a list from Janet Gerula of coaches and team managers for next year so he can confirm with them the list of players and verify that athletes have paid to play.
- Finally, Dave received positive feedback from one Laker parent regarding the new registration fee guidelines.

TREASURER

- Rick Campbell reported on the Monthly Treasurer's Report for May 2010. There was a net fundraising income for May of \$9,844.00.
- The Treasurer's Report will follow the fiscal year of July 1 through June 30.
- The Treasurer's Report form will be changed to provide a side-by side comparison of this year versus last year.

FUNDRAISING

- Mike Romkema reported for Karen who was unable to attend, that we have dates in July, August, September, October, November and December at Card Sharks on Dixie Highway. These dates have been worked around Oktoberfest, Homecoming and the Holidays.
- We want to use the Card Sharks up front, then the Sharks Club starting in the first quarter of next year, 2011.
- We will be working with the elementary school on helping organize their dates.

- Janet reported that most uniforms have been turned in. She is working on getting Fall managers organized. She asked for a hard copy of the Registration Fee Guidelines.
