

# OLL BOOSTER CLUB MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

**MEETING CALLED TO ORDER** at 7:05pm in Middle School Room 108

**OPENING PRAYER** - by Mike Romkema.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** - Motion to approve minutes from previous meeting made by Bruce Buelter, seconded by Karen Romkema: all in favor, none opposed.

**REGISTRATION/BOOSTER HOURS** - Dave reported 235 students registered for next year's sports teams from 165 families.  
- He summarized 6 CYO Basketball Teams: 1 each for Boys & Girls in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, & 8<sup>th</sup> Grades.  
- Soon, Janet Gerula is expected provide the Deadline Date for Spring Sports Registration.  
- Dave reported 975 Gaming Hours + 420 Other Hours have been worked by families thus far. This equates to 42% of total Booster Hours (165 families x 20 hours each = 3300 hours) to be worked this year, with 1/3 of the year complete. Gaming events scheduled between now and next March will allow 960 more hours, leaving 945 hours available between basketball and other events where Booster Hours can be earned. Families should contact Dave if they have questions about their Booster Hours status, and find info on the Booster website about who to contact to earn Booster Hours.

**TREASURER** - The Treasurer's report was distributed & reviewed, showing income from Gate, Concessions, and Apparel totaling ~\$4681, and several expenses totaling ~\$5556.  
- Fortunately, our balance from previous months provides us a strong financial position.

**FUNDRAISING** - New dates have been scheduled for Gaming Fundraisers and posted on the Boosters website.  
- George reported on several factors in our strategy for Gaming Fundraisers next year: venues, dates, potential increases in licensing costs, etc.  
- Several other events are planned/considered for next year: Christmas Tree Sales, Renaissance Festival Sit-Down Dinner, Candy and/or Magazine Sales, etc.

**MANAGERS** - No Report

**PRESIDENT'S REPORT** - Koeze nut sales will be handled by Mary in the Delaney Center.  
- Boosters are not responsible for school grounds upkeep other than changing concession-related garbage bags. Others are paid to maintain the OLL Parish & School Campus.  
- OLL School Board desires/plans to make OLL apparel more consistent and cost effective by purchasing from fewer vendors. A plan is and announcement is forthcoming.  
- Some individual sports teams are holding their own fundraisers, which is OK with Mr. Uberti so long as they don't solicit donations from typical sponsors of larger fundraising events.  
- Updates to the indoor concession stand will be organized by John Dean, head of the OLL School Board Building & Grounds Committee.  
- Use of the Booster email distribution list will be limited to Booster objectives of Fundraising Support for the Overall OLL Sports Programs and Increasing Attendance at Sports Events.

**CONCESSIONS/ APPAREL** - No report but comments that apparel brings ~ 20% profit.

**GATE ADMISSIONS & 50/50** - No Report

**COMMUNICATION** - Lori will update Booster website and advise Kim Dalley of requests for communication of Non-Booster subjects and events that should be handled by OLL Schools; rather than Boosters.

**OLD BUSINESS** - Discussed Booster Hours available for families to earn as described in Registration above.

**NEW BUSINESS** - Mark Monohon reported on his discussions with Ann Lowney of Everest regarding OLL student participation on Everest CYO Sports Teams and the need to consider this on OLL Sports Registration forms.
