OPENING PRAYER - by Mike Romkema.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES - Motion to approve minutes from previous meeting made by Bruce Buelter, seconded by George Goeddeke, all in favor, none opposed.

REGISTRATION

- Dave reported 221 students registered for next year's sports teams from 155 families.
- About 20 more students are expected to register based on their participation in previous years.
- 21.Sep is deadline for notifying CYO of Basketball Teams we'll be fielding this Winter

TREASURER

- The Treasurer's report was distributed & reviewed: monthly gain of \$6763 from \$9713 earned by fundraisers, bringing our YTD total to \$12,705.78 against our annual goal of \$30,000.
- Expenses included \$5550 for Exempt Registrations, \$725 for registrations returned, \$80 Apparel seed money, \$150 Bingo License, and \$29 Gate supplies.

FUNDRAISING

- Gaming Fundraisers – complete for now, until more licenses are obtained.
- George is pursuing gaming licenses for 16 more nights this year, and maybe more.
- Mike R. reported that while we won't participate in Bingo this year, we may use this as a fundraiser next year at Card Sharks. Fr. Delonnay has "blessed" this.
- Mike R. is working on visual aids to show progress toward our fundraising goal of \$30,000/yr.

MANAGERS

- Janet Gerula reported a meeting was held 16.Aug for Fall Sports Coaches & Managers.
- For Fall, 10 Team Coaches and 7 Team Managers will be exempt from Sports Registrations.

CONCESSIONS

- Larry reported remodeling of Concession Stand is nearly complete with cleaning and stocking to be done Wednesday, but **a reliable plan for the key to be made available is necessary!**
- The Bathroom in the Concession Stand is for Concession Workers only, but responsibility and a plan for cleaning it needs to be defined.
- Apparel will available for sale on a mobile display at all games.

GATE ADMISSIONS

- Shannon reported that all Fall Sport Gate Admission Positions are nearly filled and 50/50 Raffle Volunteers are signing-up.

COMMUNICATION

- Lori reported that the Booster Newsletter will be available online soon.
- Direction will be published in the Parish Bulletin "The Voice" and in School Newsletters to access the Booster Newsletter online, but paper copies will still be available in the Delaney Parish Center and in School Offices.

NEW BUSINESS

- In response to a question about receiving Booster Hours credit for work at the Palace, Mike R. proposed we consider altering the Booster Hours policy provided all our needs are covered. We will develop an estimate of all volunteer hours that need to be covered throughout the year, then assess how our membership can cover those hours. We will then clarify what hours can be credited as Booster Hours. Our goal: 20 Hours per Family - Anywhere, Anyhow!
