OPENING PRAYER - by Mike Romkema.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES - Motion to approve minutes from previous meeting made by Bruce Buelter, seconded by Shannon Ritch: all in favor, none opposed.

REGISTRATION/BOOSTER HOURS - Dave Hankey reported 20 out of 167 families have completed Booster Hours requirements, and over half of 167 families have not completed any Booster Hours at all. TREASURER - The Treasurer's report was distributed & reviewed, showing income from Gate, Concessions, and Apparel totaling \$2668.30, and expenses totaling \$999.36, for a net gain of \$1668.91.

FUNDRAISING - Mike Romkema reported that Gaming fundraisers at Red Rock have not worked out so well.
- Gaming License Applications are being submitted for Elementary & Middle Schools.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT - Mike explained the desire to have Booster Hours eliminated in lieu of a 'Whole School Fundraising Activities Enterprise' approach, planned for implementation as early as next year.

CONCESSIONS/ APPAREL - Larry has made auto window decals available for each sport at OLL – to be posted on website.
- Larry is investigating the replacement of the Nacho Cheese Machine and the Ice Maker that was taken from the concessions area by the Athletic Department.

GATE ADMISSIONS & 50/50 - Shannon reported good coverage for Gates at games, but still no volunteers for 50/50.
- She also expressed concern about cash to pay refs being taken from the gate money box, so a policy will be established to make sure that activity is well documented/recorded.
